

Minutes of Meeting
Kootenai County Sheriff's Office

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Chris Fillios, Commissioner Leslie Duncan and Commissioner Bill Brooks met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were KCSO Animal Control Officer Sandra Osburn, KCSO Deputy Dale Johnson, Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Darrin Murphey, BOCC Communications Manager Nancy Jones and Deputy Clerk Tina Ginorio. Commissioner Brooks and Mr. Murphey were present via teleconference.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Chris Fillios called the meeting to order at 1:06 p.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda (Action):** There were no changes to the agenda.
- C. Business (Action):**

Modification of Requirements for Dog which was Previously Declared Dangerous, Kenneth Wikum

KCSO Animal Control Officer Sandra Osburn explained that she had been asked to review the case. She called the Commissioners' attention to the statement from the person who had originally brought the complaint against the dog, which said the dog was no longer any sort of problem. She said the dog had never presented an apparent danger to people; it had chased and killed a couple of chickens when running loose. She added that it had grown up since then, had been neutered, and the owners had been careful to keep it under control. She recommended that the designation of "Dangerous Dog" be removed.

Commissioner Leslie Duncan said she was glad to have a case in which neighbors were able to work things out together.

All present expressed pleasure in a happy ending.

Commissioner Duncan moved that the Board remove the declaration of "Dangerous Dog" on Kenneth Wikum's dog Riot. Commissioner Bill Brooks seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Ginorio called the roll:

The motion carried.

Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Darren Murphey confirmed that this was all that was required.

BOCC staff was directed to send notification to Mr. Wikum.
