

Minutes of Meeting
Requests for Cancellation of Taxes
April 7, 2021
9:00 a.m.

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Chris Fillios, Commissioner Leslie Duncan, and Commissioner Bill Brooks met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Acting Chief Deputy Treasurer Mary Bidwell, Civil Deputy Prosecutor R. David Ferguson, BOCC Administrative Secretary Teri Johnston, and Deputy Clerk Ronnie Davisson. Also present via teleconference were citizens Jillian Bruna, Julie Weaver and Debbie Spence.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Chris Fillios called the meeting to order at 9:02 a.m.
- B. Introductions:** There were no introductions made.
- C. Changes to the Agenda (Action):** There were no changes to the agenda.
- D. Action Items:**

Request for Cancellation of Taxes/AIN Nos. 313453; 313454; 313456; 313457; 313458; 313460/Idaho State Veterans Home/Post Falls

Chairman Fillios directed the clerk to swear in all participants.

Acting Chief Deputy Treasurer Mary Bidwell said that the request was to cancel taxes for the Veteran's Home from the year 2019, as well as any associated late charges and interest. She noted that the special assessment fee, which was \$5.74, would remain on each of the properties for the two years that were due.

Commissioner Duncan moved to approve the request for cancellation of taxes, interest, and penalties, with the Aquifer Protection District fee to remain on AIN Nos. 313453; 313454; 313456; 313457; 3134578; 313460 for the Idaho State Veteran's Home. Commissioner Brooks seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Davisson called the roll:

Request for Cancellation of Taxes/AIN No. 121945/Bruna/Smith

Ms. Bidwell said there was a request from the homeowner to reduce fees and to allow her to make payments to avoid the loss of her home. She said the Treasurer's Office recommended cancellation of all late charges and interest, which was a total of \$976.03, with the conditions of payments as outlined. Ms. Bidwell explained the first payment would be due within thirty days, totaling \$1491.42; the second would be due by October 31, totaling \$1037.63; and the remainder would be paid in full by June 2022.

Commissioner Duncan moved to approve the request for cancellation of late charge and interest in the amount of \$976.03 for AIN No. 121945, as long as the proposed payment schedule is adhered to. Commissioner Brooks seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Davisson called the roll:
