

Minutes of Meeting
North Idaho Fair Board Quarterly Update
June 15, 2023
11:00 a.m.

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chair Leslie Duncan, Commissioner Bruce Mattare and Commissioner Bill Brooks met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were BOCC Communications Coordinator Jonathan Gillham and Deputy Clerk Tina Ginorio. Also present was North Idaho Fair General Manager Alexcia Jordan. Commissioner Brooks was present via teleconference.

- A. Call to Order:** Chair Leslie Duncan called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda (Action):** There were no changes to the agenda.

North Idaho Fair Board Quarterly Update with Fair Director Alexcia Jordan (Discussion)

North Idaho Fair General Manager Alexcia Jordan remarked that this would be the last meeting before the Fair. She stated that they had 116 sponsors, 215 vendors, 40 concessions, over 30 carnival rides and they were finalizing the entertainment schedules, with three main stages, two demonstration stages and five grounds attractions.

Ms. Jordan announced that the exhibits were now open and provided the Exhibit Manuals to the Commissioners, in case they were inclined to enter projects. She said that pre-sales were going very well, with the Saturday Rodeo almost sold out already, as well as one of the concerts. She reminded the Commissioners that the Apple Pie Contest would be held at 11:00 a.m. on August 24.

Fair Board Vice Chair Elise Burton entered the meeting at 11:05 a.m.

Ms. Jordan commented that their team had suffered a great loss this year, when their entertainment coordinator passed away.

Ms. Jordan provided posters and a yard sign to be put up in the Administrative Building. She reminded everyone that entering an exhibit was free, except for livestock. She encouraged everyone to enter.

Commissioner Bill Brooks said he felt the Fair was one of the things that makes Kootenai County special. He added that the Fair Board was one of the best Boards in the County.

- D. Public Comment:** This section is reserved for citizens wishing to address the Board regarding a County related issue. Idaho Law prohibits Board action on items brought under this section except in an emergency circumstance. Comments related to future public hearings should be held for that public hearing. There were no public comments.
