Case No. Resolution 2022 Proposed Community Development Fee Schedule. At the time of this public hearing the resolution number had not been provided. Chris Garland conveyed the need to increase fees to cover cost of Budget line items 8040 & 8041(motor fuels & lubricants and vehicle maintenance & expenses). There is an increase of requested inspections and longer drive times. Currently 6 Inspectors and 1 Planner drive approximately 500 miles per day. This does not include an occasional inspection performed by our Deputy Building Official and a 2nd Planner. The current Fee Resolution 2021-54, under "Building Division Fees" based on the local information and the most current date published by the International Code Council. Exhibit A & B, fees have not been altered from 2006 until 2019. Exhibit D, Mechanical fees have not been altered from 2006. We have requested an Administrative Submittal Processing fee. This fee will cover the cost of all permit submittal processing, currently the Permit Technicians that process building permits, especially if one chooses to cancel a Building permit, than no fee will be collected. Cover cost of added Building Department Staff.

Commissioner Duncan and Chairman Fillios affirmed the signing of this Resolution at the June 21, 2022 Business Meeting.
