

**Minutes of Meeting**  
**Request for Cancellation of Taxes**  
**July 7, 2022**  
**9:00 a.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chair Pro Tem Leslie Duncan and Commissioner Bill Brooks met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were Assessor Bela Kovacs, Land Records Manager Tony Harbison, Treasury Specialist Supervisor Dee Ann Reed, Civil Deputy Prosecutor R. David Ferguson, BOCC Communications Coordinator Jonathan Gillham, BOCC Administrative Secretary Teri Johnston, and Deputy Clerk Ronnie Davisson. Commissioner Brooks and Mr. Ferguson were present via teleconference. Also present was Kootenai County Resident Randy Uchtyl.

- A. **Call to Order:** Chair Pro Tem Leslie Duncan called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m.

- 1. **Request for Adjustments – Northern Lakes Fire District Fees/AIN 129607/Uchtyl (Action)**

Mr. Randy Uchtyl explained that he had been unsuccessful at trying to get de-annexed from the Northern Lake Fire District and mentioned that he had been in touch with the Fire Chief to work on the de-annexation. Commissioner Duncan said that there had even been a letter from the Northern Lakes Fire Chief to Treasurer Steve Matheson stating that Mr. Uchtyl's property was not within the Fire District.

Civil Deputy Prosecutor R. David Ferguson pointed out that if the property was approved for de-annexation in the future, then the Board would be able to issue a refund for tax adjustments at that time.

Commissioner Duncan advised Mr. Uchtyl to keep in contact with their office on the status of de-annexation.

There were no adjustments made.

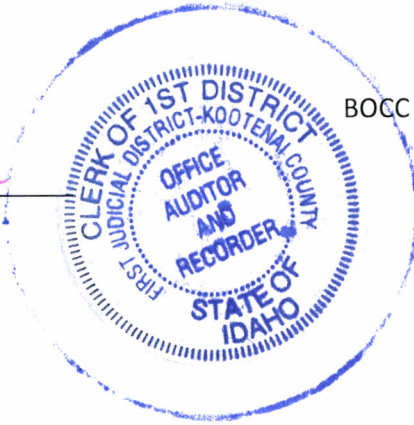
G. **Adjourn:** Chair Pro Tem Duncan adjourned the meeting at 9:12 a.m.
