

Minutes of Meeting

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Chris Fillios and Commissioner Leslie Duncan met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Assessor's Office Administrative Manager Reba Grytness, BOCC Administrative Secretary Teri Johnston and Deputy Clerk Tina Ginorio. Commissioner Bill Brooks was excused.

Request Adjustment of Taxes to Reflect Circuit Breaker/AIN 223192/Tennison Living Trust

Assessor's Office Administrative Manager Reba Grytness was sworn in by Deputy Clerk Tina Ginorio.

Ms. Grytness stated that Mr. Tennison had thought his paperwork had been completed and did not need to be renewed. She said he was homebound, due to his medical condition. She stated that he was eligible for both the Circuit Breaker Program and the benefit for a 100% Disabled Veteran but noted that the \$1,500 Veteran's Tax Exemption would cover his whole tax bill and suggested the Commissioners act accordingly.

Commissioner Leslie Duncan moved that the Board grant the 100% VA Service Connected Disabled Exemption, up to the amount of \$1,500, resulting in a cancellation of taxes. Chairman Fillios seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Ginorio called the roll:
