

Resolution 2018-106
(Classification of Records of the Kootenai County Elections Department)

WHEREAS, the records of the Kootenai County Elections Department are county records under *Idaho Code* §34-217 and §31-871

WHEREAS, County election records shall be maintained by the county clerk for the period specified beginning with the date the record is created or has become no longer valid, whichever is greater;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the following records within the care, custody, and control of the Kootenai County Elections Department, to wit:

2013 August School District Levy Election:

- Poll Books (1 envelope);
34-217(1)(c), five-year retention

2013 November Taxing District Election:

- Poll Books (1 box);
34-217(1)(c), five-year retention

2016 November General Election:

- Voted ballots (56 boxes);
 - 34-217(2)(c), two-year retention
- Absentee ballot requests and ballot stubs (7 boxes)
 - 34-217(2)(a), two-year retention
- Absentee ballot affidavit envelopes (8 boxes)
 - 34-217(3)(a), one-year retention
- Test deck ballots (2 boxes);
 - 31-871(c) as these are not addressed by 34-217, two-year temporary retention
- Stubs (from voted ballots) (6 boxes);
 - 31-871(c) as these are not addressed by 34-217, two-year temporary retention

2018 May Primary Election

- Unused ballots (38 boxes);
 - 34-217(4), 60-day retention

FURTHER, that the foregoing election records have surpassed the requisite time under *Idaho Code* §34-217 and §31-871 for retention.
