WHEREAS, Ms. Kane requested the reduction of the 2022 taxes to reflect the Circuit Breaker on the above referenced parcel as Ms. Kane failed to file by the deadline due to medical issues; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners on December 7, 2022 at a properly noticed meeting, agreed to adjust the taxes for 2022 to reflect the circuit breaker and cancel interest, penalties and late charges; and

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the taxes for the 2022 tax year be adjusted to reflect a circuit breaker and that interest, penalties and late charges be cancelled.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Assessor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.

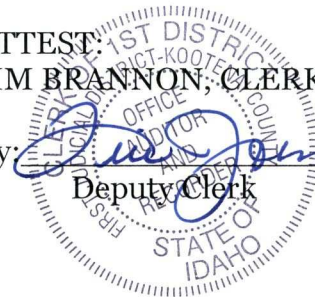
