

Resolution 2022-87
Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/KCSO

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has on its asset list one (1) 1997 AVON Inflatable Boat, Asset #1282, HIN # AVB0709J697 which, was a donation to the Marine Division and Dive Team by Avista, and is currently not being used for its intended purpose; and

WHEREAS, the equipment described herein above no longer has value; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office desires to dispose of the boat as it is no longer serviceable.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the boat described hereinabove be and hereby are declared to be unusable property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property in accordance with Idaho law.
