Destruction of Records of the Kootenai County Elections Department

WHEREAS, the records of the Kootenai County Elections Department are county records under *Idaho Code* §34-217 & 31-871; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of County records to list, in detail records to be destroyed;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Elections Department as referenced in Resolution 2022-85 are authorized to be destroyed;

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the records shall be under the direction and supervision of the Clerk of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners.


