

Resolution 2022-82
Surplus Equipment/Asset Deletion/KCSO

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-808 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the County under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office has on its asset list one (1) 1991 EZ Sonar-1 Boat Trailer, Asset #1283, VIN #1ZE1UT833MA007773 which, due to age, repair and safety concerns are of no further use to the County; and

WHEREAS, the equipment described hereinabove have a value in excess of \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office desires to trade the Boat Trailer to Lake City Marine Repair in for future repairs.

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office desires to have the trailer declared as surplus property, and donated to the entities listed above;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the trailer described hereinabove be and hereby are declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property in accordance with Idaho law.
