## .Resolution 2023-55 Reinstate Assessor Salary

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to *Idaho Code* §31-3106, it shall be the duty of the Board of County Commissioners to set the annual salaries of the County Elected Officials; and,

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners voted to reduce the Assessor's salary to \$45,000 effective October 1, 2022 for the reasons stated in the August 31, 2022 Kootenai County budget hearing; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners was ordered by the Court in Case No. CV28-22-5938 to reinstate the Assessor's salary to \$90,387.96, with an additional 6% increase retroactive to September 25, 2022;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the salary of the Assessor shall be set as follows:

- 1. The Assessor's salary shall be \$95,811.24 for fiscal year 2023; and,
- 2. The Board of County Commissioners hereby directs the Kootenai County Clerk to pay the Assessor the difference in the Assessor's current salary retroactive from September 25, 2022, through the current date, and with the salary hereby ordered to be paid for the remainder of fiscal year 2023.
