

**JUVENILE CHAPLAIN, YOUTH  
ADVOCACY AND COMMUNITY  
OUTREACH AGREEMENT**

This Agreement is made between **KOOTENAI COUNTY**, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho, 501 N. Government Way, P.O. Box 9000, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho 83816-9000 ("the County"), and **Jackson Lanterman** ("the Chaplain").

The parties agree as follows:

1. **Purpose:** The purpose of this Agreement is to provide spiritual and moral guidance, individually and in group sessions, to juveniles and their families; to facilitate interactive discussion groups with juveniles, and to encourage and maintain supportive community relationships for this project.

2. **Target Population:** The juveniles targeted for this project are those who are clients of the Juvenile Probation and Juvenile Detention Center.

3. **Duties:**

- a. The Chaplain agrees to schedule, supervise, and coordinate non-denominational religious services conducted in the Region 1 Juvenile Detention Center in accordance with the policies and procedures of the Juvenile Detention Center, and in compliance with all applicable federal, state and local laws.
- b. The Chaplain agrees to coordinate and schedule time in the local high schools or other community public places to meet with clients on Juvenile Probation to provide support and encouragement to these youth outside of the confines of the detention center, during the course of their probationary period.
- c. The Chaplain understands and agrees to conform to all departmental

policies set forth in rules and regulations, general orders, and applicable orders, in all aspects and functions of his duties as Juvenile Chaplain.

- d. The Chaplain shall assist, when appropriate, with referral of juvenile clients and their families to community social services based upon the needs and applicability of the referred services.
- e. The Chaplain shall perform his duties with the interests of the juvenile clients and families in mind, being cognizant of the responsibility of this position and conducting himself in a manner which reflects favorably upon the position he holds.
- f. The Chaplain shall encourage education and understanding of the Chaplain's Program by preparing and giving presentations to community groups which explain and interpret the program.
- g. The Chaplain agrees to maintain a positive contact with other local chaplains, religious leaders, and juvenile services staff, in order to build and maintain mutually supportive relationships.

**4. Time and Place of Performance:** The parties agree that the Chaplain shall commence work in a timely manner and shall perform the duties set forth in this Agreement at the Kootenai County Juvenile Probation Department, 205 N 4th Street, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, the Region 1 Juvenile Detention Center, 210 E. Dalton Avenue, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho, and such other places as the County may designate.

**5. Hours and Compensation:** The parties agree and understand that this is a contract position consisting of 15 hours per week, with an hourly wage of \$19.00. In the event of termination of this Agreement as set forth in section 12 below, compensation shall be paid for those hours that the Chaplain actually worked prior to the effective date of

termination.

6. **Independent Contractor**: The parties agree that the Chaplain is an independent contractor and, as such, is not in any way an employee or agent of the County and is not entitled to Worker's Compensation or any benefits of employment provided by the County to its employees. Further, it is agreed that the County has no control over the performance of this Agreement by the Chaplain except to specify the time and place of performance.

7. **Non-assignable**: The parties mutually agree that the County has entered into this Agreement to secure the personal services of the Chaplain and, as such, this Agreement is not subject to transfer, assignment, or conveyance.

8. **Compliance with Laws**: The Chaplain agrees to comply with all federal, state, city, and local laws, rules, and regulations as set forth by the courts in performance of this Agreement.

9. **Qualifications**: CHAPLAIN will furnish the COUNTY with proof of ordination as a minister, priest, or pastor, or person duly accredited by, and in good standing with, a nationally recognized religious body.

10. **Indemnity**: CHAPLAIN agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the COUNTY, its employees and agents for any liability, claims, or damages arising out of, or in any way connected with, CHAPLAIN'S performance of the work described in this Agreement.

11. **Insurance**: CHAPLAIN agrees to maintain professional liability insurance naming COUNTY as an additional insured, and furnish the COUNTY with proof of said insurance. Required insurance coverage amount of (\$1 Million Each Event Limit/ \$3 Million Aggregate Limit).

12. **Termination:** This Agreement may be terminated by written notice by either party prior to October 1, 2023. This Agreement will automatically expire on September 30, 2023, if not terminated in writing by either party prior thereto.

13. **General Provisions:** This Agreement supersedes and replaces any pre-existing contracts and agreements between the Contractor and the County. This Agreement contains the entire understanding and agreement between the parties, including any and all material terms agreed to between the Contractor and the County. If any provision is held to be unenforceable, then such provision shall be excluded without affecting the remaining provisions of this Agreement.



**I have read the foregoing and understand the terms of this agreement are contractually and legally binding, and that no verbal statement to the contrary, by any person or entity, can void or alter the terms of this agreement.**

I understand this release does not waive any rights I may have under the Worker's Compensation Laws of the State of Idaho, or any protection I may have under the Tort Claims Act; however, I also expressly understand and acknowledge this release does not create any rights not specifically and expressly provided to me Under the Workers' Compensation Laws or the Tort Claims Act.


