

**ORDER GRANTING
RESPONDENT'S MOTION FOR
REFERRAL TO ADMINISTRATIVE
DISTRICT JUDGE RE:
VEXATIOUS LITIGATION**

This matter having come before the Court on February 27, 2024, on a Motion For Referral to Administrative District Judge re: Vexatious Litigation, brought by Jamila Holmes, Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for Kootenai County, and the Court being fully apprised in the premises and good cause existing,


IT IS HEREBY ORDERD that the State's Motion For Referral to Administrative District Judge: Re Vexatious Litigation is GRANTED, which means that this matter is hereby referred to the First District Administrative Judge, Lamont C. Berecz, to determine whether to designate the Plaintiff, Wylie Gail Hunter, a vexatious litigant, pursuant to I.C.A.R. 59. Within the past seven years, Mr. Hunter has commenced at least three litigations *pro se*, against the State of Idaho, to-wit: (1) Kootenai County Case CV28-21-4427: *Wylie G. Hunter v. State of Idaho, District Judge Lansing L.*

Haynes, Prosecutor Barry McHugh, and Former Deputy Prosecutor Ann Wick; (2) United States District Court, District of Idaho, Case No. 1:19-CV-01113-DCN: Wylie G. Hunter v. State of Idaho, Governor Brad Little, Attorney General Lawrence Wasden, Kootenai County Prosecutor Barry McHugh, Former Deputy Prosecutor Ann Wick, ISP Detective Terry Morgan, Deputy Attorney General Stephanie Nemore, ISP Captain Curtis Kastens, ISP Investigative Assistant Lisa Correia, ISP Administrative Assistant Christie Redenbo, ISP Management Assistant Amy Jordan, and Does 1-5; and (3) United States District Court, District of Idaho, case No. 1:19-cv-0227-BLW: Wylie G. Hunter v. State of Idaho, Governor Brad Little, District Judge Lansing Haynes, Prosecutor Barry McHugh, Former Deputy Prosecutor Ann Wick, ISP Detective Terry Morgan, ISP Trooper Ron Suffon, Retained Attorneys: John Redal, Doug Phelps and James Siebe, Investigator Ted Pulver, States Witnesses Misty Whitehead and Richard Shabazian, and Does 1-5.

Additionally, the undersigned has reviewed the entire file in this instant case (CV-2016-4345) and taken judicial notice of such as facts. The Court is entitled to do so under I.R.E. 201(c)(1) on its own accord, and as the Court is required to do now that this case has been reassigned to this Court on January 19, 2024.

This Court now finds good cause exists due to Wylie Gail Hunter's repeatedly filling unmeritorious claims, and refers this matter to Administrative Judge Lamont C. Berecz, pursuant to I.C.A.R. 59(c), to enter a prefilling order requiring Wylie Gail Hunter to obtain leave of the Administrative Judge before filing any new litigation, and for the Administrative Judge to find Wylie Gail Hunter to be a "vexatious litigant" as set forth in I.C.A.R. 59(1)(2), and (3).
