

**Resolution 2024-16  
Destroy Records/Juvenile Detention**

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires a resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and

**WHEREAS**, an audit of certain county records in the possession of Kootenai County Juvenile Detention, has been performed, and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

**NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that the records of Kootenai County Juvenile Detention attached as “Exhibit A” and incorporated into Resolution 2024-15 adopted on February 6, 2024 are authorized to be destroyed.
