

Resolution 2013-56
Destruction of Records/Background Packets of
Applicants Not Selected for Hire
August 2008 – December 2010

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 states that county records may only be destroyed by resolution of the Board of County Commissioners; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-871 requires the resolution ordering destruction and disposition of county records to list, in detail, records to be destroyed; and,

WHEREAS, an audit of certain county records in the possession of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office having been performed and legal advice having been sought and given regarding the disposal of said records;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the records of the Kootenai County Sheriff's Office related to Background Packets of Applicants Not Selected for Hire/August 2008 – December 2010 have surpassed the statutory retention period as public records and therefore may be destroyed.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the destruction and disposition of the Background Packets of Applicants Not Selected for Hire identified in Resolution 2013-55 shall be done under the direction and supervision of the Kootenai County Sheriff.
