

Resolution 2013-94
Retirement of Sheriff's K-9 Iron

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in, in his/her judgment, is of no further use to the county, he may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Sheriff has in his possession one (1) trained law enforcement canine by the name of Iron; and

WHEREAS, due to health issues, K9 Iron is no longer able to perform law enforcement duties; and

WHEREAS, the former handler of K9 Iron has indicated a willingness to assume full responsibility, and is uniquely qualified to care for K9 Iron; and

WHEREAS, K9 Iron's value is less than \$250.00;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that K9 Iron shall be retired from the Kootenai County Sheriff's Department K-9 Unit, and in the best interests of his health and well being he shall be sold to his handler, Deputy Nathan Nelson for one dollar (\$1.00) pursuant to the proposed Bill of Sale, and Iron shall live out his retirement as a pet in consideration of his loyal service to Kootenai County.
