

Resolution 2012-115
Surplus Christmas Decorations/Building & Grounds

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS, *Idaho Code* §31-829 provide that whenever any elected official has any property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Building & Grounds Department has in its possession two (2) reindeer Christmas decorations and seven (7) strings of Christmas lights which are of no further use to the county due to age and disrepair; and

WHEREAS, the items described hereinabove have a value of less than \$250.00; and

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Building & Grounds Department desires to have the above referenced equipment declared as surplus property;

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the property described above be, and hereby is, declared to be surplus property, and in accordance therewith, the Board of County Commissioners may take action to dispose of said property by public or private sale or to dispose of the property as it sees fit, in accordance with Idaho law.
