

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-70
Surplus Property – Office of Emergency Management

WHEREAS *Idaho Code* §31-807 vests the Board of County Commissioners with the power and authority to manage real and personal property for the benefit of the County; and

WHEREAS *Idaho Code* §31-829 provides that whenever any elected official has any personal property belonging to the county under his/her jurisdiction or control which, in his/her judgment is of no further use to the county, he/she may, with the consent of the Board of County Commissioners, have the property declared as surplus and dispose of the property through sale or other means; and

WHEREAS the Office of Emergency Management has thirty thousand, seven hundred and twenty (30,720) dust masks that are past their recommended shelf life by over twenty five (25) years which were shipped to the county for use during the Mt. St. Helens eruption in 1980; and

WHEREAS this particular model of dust mask; 3M Model 8710 has been found to be defective and the subject of multiple litigation matters against the manufacturer and;

WHEREAS based on the extreme age and the liability associated with the use of these subject dust masks, the masks should be declared as surplus property and be disposed of in a manner that will preclude them from being placed into service in any capacity.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that the dust masks are hereby declared to be surplus property.
