

Resolution 2011-109
Authorize Chairman's Signature on Kennel Licenses

WHEREAS, an application for a kennel license is to be made to the office of the Board of County Commissioners (*Kootenai County Ordinance 5-1B-1*); and

WHEREAS, the application shall state the name and address of the owner, the location of the kennel and types and breeds of animals to be kept; and

WHEREAS, the kennel licenses shall not be transferred, and shall be valid for one year; and

WHEREAS, an authorized officer or a deputy of the county sheriff shall inspect all prospective kennels prior to granting a kennel license, and any application must include the written approval of the inspecting officer; and

WHEREAS, applications for a kennel license must include written approval from the county zoning department showing that the kennel is in compliance with all requirements, standards and conditions established by the county zoning department;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners hereby delegates to the Chairman of the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners the authority to review and execute on behalf of the Board any and all Kennel Licenses presented to the Board for approval.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that such delegation shall not be construed as a relinquishment of the ultimate authority of the Board of County Commissioners in matters involving Kennel Licenses.
