

Resolution 2009-20
Adjust 2008 Taxes to Reflect Circuit Breaker
Parcel No. C472500B007A/AIN 117679 /Parker

WHEREAS, the Kootenai County Board of Commissioners has received a request for adjustment of the 2008 property taxes on Parcel No. C472500B007A, record owner being Phillip Parker, 2815 N Howard St, Coeur d' Alene, ID 83815; and,

WHEREAS, the owner of the subject property has qualified for the Circuit Breaker Exemption in previous years, but failed to apply in 2008 because he was no longer using a payee to assist him and was not aware of the need to reapply each year, and,

WHEREAS, the Assessor's office has made a recommendation to the Board of Commissioners for a tax reduction to reflect a full circuit breaker exemption of \$1320.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the 2008 taxes be reduced by up to \$1320 to reflect the full circuit breaker reduction.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the Treasurer and Auditor be directed to take appropriate action to effectuate said resolution.
